HEAD OF MASS COMMUNICATION DEPARTMENT UPDATES ON FASHION TRENDS AND CAMPUS CULTURE.

Mrs. Sarah Iko Fowobaje, (HOD) of the department of mass communication, this day morning in an interview with the spokesmen from AuraAtire made a full statement on fashion and her view on fashion sense in the department.

'As mass communication students your fashion sense should be guided by modesty reason being that you will be interacting with different kinds of people, getting information you would have to meet with people therefore your training should have a way of inculcating good dress sense no matter the trends' she further stated in her interview section. She

further explained that how mass communicators dress determines the extent of their access to duties and the people in power in carrying out their jobs.

stated. She further explained that good fashion sense should be a normal tradition for mass communication students Good fashion sense should be a part of the job as they have tried to mould and mature department students to dress with integrity and prestige to be presentable when the time comes. She went further to blame social media as one of the causes of the students' poor choice of fashion sense of the students.

"I have come to the class from time to time and seen girls trying to copy Cardi-B, Rihanna and also same for the boys not minding the implication of those habits, once this becomes a habit the students lose consciousness of how they are supposed to dress she"

Furthermore, she explained that celebrities such as Cardi- B and the likes are brands and also represent other brands and as such try to sell their names or brands for profits. Still, on the matter of fashion sense, she stated that one loses opportunities because of how poorly they are dressed. On the issue of dress codes for mass communication students when HOD of asked, the mass communication explained that the management of the school was to be involved in such a decision. She referred to back in the days when mass communication students had dress codes, but the just passed administration kicked against the idea. the reason being that

students may feel like they are in secondary school and therefore countered the idea. "I am trying to see how we could our students to embrace professionalism when it comes to dressing we have a dress code for the week" She also glanced through the detailed information on what the dress code is for the week. The HOD went further to defend the weekly dress code stating that students get carried away by the independence on campus thereby dressing with poor fashion sense, but the idea of the weekly dress code keeps the students in check and not completely drift away from dressing correctly.

"You are in the business of news gathering and soliciting information which can come up any time there will be no permission asked " she stated clearly to explain that events take permission from no one, therefore as а iournalist communicator one has to be dressed properly and prepared. Still during the interview when asked to share her thoughts on trends and challenges of fashion journalism, she bluntly disappointed with the turn fashion journalism is taking.

She pointed out a few observations stating that presenters of soft programs nowadays dress inappropriately and nearly expose sensitive areas. Therefore affecting viewers also stated that the embrace of the Western lifestyle could be cut back a little.

"For me, I see it like it is eluding professionalism because before anchoring a program you should be dressed properly" she stressed.

Mrs Sarah also added that communicators are carried away with the fact and sole aim of saving the magazine, airtime and other products of the profession while completely neglecting the key functions of journalism.

She also went further to state the key skills and knowledge areas if students wish to venture into fashion journalism.

"Photography is key when you want to do fashion journalism, your good sense of what makes a good picture is key because it is the composition of the picture that attracts your viewership" She also told AuraAtire spokesman that journalist agenda ability to set the right agenda should be the key sense and knowledge when venturing into any arm of journalism.

She stressed that the role of gatekeepers in fashion journalism is to filter inappropriate pictures before publishing it to the consumers.

" If you don't publicize and celebrate nudity, it will die a natural death".

Furthermore, she stated that being a journalist is all about professionalism, and also being gatekeepers and agenda setters is being able to change the narratives of what journalism has become today.

She further stressed the fact that fashion journalist can influence their viewers and change their minds completely.

She finally advised that communicators who wish to take up fashion magazines and journalism have to identify what makes good fashion within the jurisdiction of what may be their respect and what fashion sense is embraced by them.

She explained that if publicizing the kind of fashion that is not familiar with the area of coverage of the journalist the goal intended in terms of viewership may not be achieved.

"This is a kind of northern setting, you will find out that the more dive into western dressing you may not get the viewership you intended like you would when publicizing the native nature of your area of coverage".

Mrs Sarah then advised that new fashion journalists should study and know well about their area of coverage studying the pattern and reproducing or giving back what they embraced.







